The International English Language Testing System (IELTS) is recognised world-wide by governments, employers and education providers. It assesses the English language proficiency levels of people who want to study or work in an English-speaking country (such as Australia) where English is the main language.

IELTS test results are based on an overall band score from 1.0 (non-user) to 9.0 (expert user). For most vocational and higher education courses, you will need to achieve an overall band score of between 6.0 and 7.5 to be eligible to apply for enrolment in courses at those institutions.

Our Preparation for IELTS course teaches you to develop the main language learning skills in:

- ◆ speaking: expressing ideas and opinions, seeking clarification, pronunciation
- ◆ writing: grammatical accuracy, interpreting questions, organising content.
- ◆ listening: note-taking, listening for specific information
